Support team requirements

- Be at least 18 years of age.
- Go through the official application process, filling in your application form by the set deadline.
- Cover your own travel, accommodation, food and beverages, visa, and any other costs related to the event.
- Commit to joining either for 24 or 40 hours of volunteering during a 2-week or 3-week period, respectively.
- Before the start of the event: Attend a couple of pre-event calls and go through the prepared materials. If it's not possible to attend live calls, recordings will be provided.
- Support the Mindvalley University Team in your shifts according to the schedule confirmed by the Crew Lead.
- Attend team meetings during your shift.

What would you be doing?

Supporting the Mindvalley University Team with any kind of tasks related to the execution of the event in Tallinn, some of the potential tasks are listed below:

• Support with the registration of the attendees on the site – welcoming customers, confirming the attendee tickets, assigning wristbands, sharing information and giving directions, checking waiver forms, etc.



- Support in the seminar rooms in various tasks mic running, managing the stage, changing the setup of the room if needed, etc
- Support with managing the hub for the event logistical tasks, help with re-filling the water tanks, moving chairs, furniture, banners, etc.
- Support with the toddlers, kids, and/or teens program filling different roles based on the instructions from the main lead for youth programs.
- Support with evening & social events assisting the main lead for the evening and/or social events in various roles, such as checking wristbands, welcoming customers, etc.
- Assisting with the setup for the morning activities (yoga, fitness, meditation, breathwork) before the main programming at the Hub.
- Other similar tasks for which the instructions will be provided by the event lead.

Essential skills:

- Fluent in both spoken and written English.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills.
- Adaptability in a fast-moving environment.
- Excellent problem-solving skills and resourcefulness.
- Self-starter who can take the initiative and is proactive in contributing toward the team and goals.
- Interest in personal growth would be nice to have. :)

In exchange for the time, commitment, and energy, Mindvalley University Support Team members receive the following:

- A free 2-week or a 3-week pass for Mindvalley University in exchange for 24 hours of volunteer work (around 3 days) for the 2-week pass and 40 hours of volunteer work (around 5 days) for the 3-week pass.
- Access to all the Event Sessions, once your shift is complete.
- Free Mindvalley Membership for one year.
- An amazing experience working with the team who has been putting together world-class events all over the globe and being part of something transformational which is changing the way education works in this fast-paced world of ours.
- Access to a global Tribe of extraordinary people.
- Invitation letter in case you need to apply for a Schengen visa.
